The aim of the study is to provide recommendations to remove market barrier, create market demand and enhance technology innovation

Outcome of the study will be useful for policy recommendation i.e. Malaysia Plastics Sustainability Roadmap 2021-2030

Stimulating Plastic Recycling Markets & Design-for-Recycling

For the beverage packaging as in PET bottles, the identified minimum eco-design requirements are:

- 👉 Uniform material for body and lid/bottle cap
- 👉 Material density of less than 1 g/m³
- 👉 Uniform material for label
- 👉 Durable and fit for use with regards to shelf-life and logistic purposes
- 👉 Minimize printing area
- 👉 Use non-toxic printing ink






